DESCRIPTION

Electrix has been consistently undertaking construction and maintenance activities on both the Powercor and CitiPower distribution networks for a period which now extends beyond twelve years. This successful long-term relationship was first formalised in 2001 with the signing of a 'Period Works Partnering Agreement' with Powercor. That initial agreement has subsequently been successfully renewed and extended on a number of occasions with the latest contract agreement running to July 2018.

This work is undertaken from Electrix depots at Laverton in Melbourne and regional Geelong with resources also regularly deployed to Victorian regional locations.

SCOPE

The scope of work currently includes:

- Supply of Glove and Barrier and general line-worker resources and associated plant;
- Undertaking maintenance activities including pole and cross arm replacement;
- Undertaking metering and servicing activities;
- Undertaking customer initiated capital works;
- Provision of after hours availability and support as required.

Further long-term contracts are also in place with both Powercor and CitiPower for undertaking public lighting maintenance, asset inspection and minor maintenance, load monitoring and specialised testing services.

Together these contracts establish Electrix as the largest specialist electrical service provider to Powercor and CitiPower.
