DESCRIPTION

Energex required construction and maintenance services on the Energex distribution network in the Brisbane region.

SCOPE

Works included replacement of poles and cross arms, up-rating pole and ground mounted substations, RMU maintenance and both overhead and underground system maintenance and construction.

The contract involved significant planning and co-ordination with Energex and required Electrix to meet stringent contract KPI's.

Around 26 additional technical and administration staff members to be employed for the duration of the contract. Electrix were able to meet this requirement due to its continuing investment in staff recruitment and training.
