

## SP AusNET Public Lighting Maintenance

### DESCRIPTION

The SP AusNet Public Lighting Maintenance contract is for the provision of Public Lighting Maintenance and Bulk Change Services across their Network in Victoria, Australia.

The contract covers the outer eastern and northern suburbs of Melbourne plus the eastern half of Victoria and is for an initial term of three years.

### SCOPE

Under the contract Electrix will provide the following services for the 108,000 public lights managed by SP AusNet:

- Maintenance and repair of street lighting reported as faulty or defective by the public and customers
- Routine patrols to identify and repair defective lights
- Bulk change programs for cyclical replacement of globes
- Replacement of existing lights with energy efficient fittings
- Supply and logistics management for all light fittings and materials required for the works

The award of this contract builds on the successful 5 year relationship between the two organisations and expanded on the range of services already being provided by Electrix.

The contract is being managed from a newly expanded Electrix office in Thomastown and utilises existing personnel located across this region.

### VALUE TO CLIENT
